Heather Knight from UKCISA, the UK Council for International Student Affairs, will outline how staff and students can keep on top of the ever-changing immigration landscape in the UK via the immigration and advisory support that UKCISA offers. Kevin Chevillon from ESPA UK will discuss how ESPA supports the visa process and relocation to the UK for students recruited for internships and how they also support students and universities enquiring on cost and process to obtain the appropriate visa. ESPA facilitates year-round internships with UK based businesses for students and recent graduates through their free of charge, financially supported programme for students and universities.
